THE VIRTUE OF HOPE

Too often the virtue of hope is neglected, while we speak about faith and charity. It is quite easy to neglect the virtue of hope, which a mistake because the virtue of hope is really the virtue of the pilgrim. It is the virtue of the one who is on the move, it is the virtue of the one who thinks of the goal towards which they are moving, towards which they are walking. Now, it is natural, I would say, for someone who sets out on a journey, that they have no other ideas during their journey, than to reach the goal they have set out to achieve. It's obvious, it's clear. Otherwise, when you ask them – Where are you going? – Well, I don't know, I don't think about it, I haven't thought about it... It goes without saying, if you ask a traveller where they are going, they will say: - I will see this, I will see that, I will meet so-and-so... They are always fixed on the goal towards which they are going.

So, it's a bit surprising not to think, reflect, or meditate enough, on the goal we are moving towards. It would be so natural to think about it all the time because we're always on the way. We are on a journey, we are pilgrims.

So, if we ask ourselves what hope is, we can answer that it is really the thought of heaven. Here again, the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass puts us in contact with heaven. Our Lord opens the gates of heaven to us, and it is eternity towards which we walk. He brings us closer to eternity, through his cross. For this reason, we must not hesitate to speak often to the faithful also of their last ends,

of heaven, of the Holy Trinity, of the state of souls in heaven, of the elect, of the angels, of the Virgin Mary present in heaven, of all the saints, of the communion of saints in heaven. To speak also of our guardian angel who sees heaven, as Our Lord says: "We must not scandalize those children whose angels see God." Our guardian angel sees God. He doesn't just hope, he's there. So let us ask him to help us think of heaven and to live more in this virtue of hope.

And for this reason, let us not neglect the last lessons given to us in our theology on the last ends. Unfortunately, sometimes it happens that, if the teacher is a little late in his lessons, he says: "Oh, you know the last endings, it's not difficult, you'll see for yourself." And then we end the year like this, and then we haven't seen the last ends. It shouldn't be like that because it's too important. If you have all these truths of the last ends, you know, there is nothing that carries souls away like the desire for heaven! The desire to reach the goal, of this beatific vision. So put yourselves in this atmosphere of hope too.
