ALL APOSTLES!

The sacrament of confirmation, like the sacrament of baptism, marks our souls with a character, a sign which is precisely the sign of the Holy Spirit and which marks our souls for the whole of life. And thanks to this sacrament, we receive the gift of strength in a very special way; we become through the sacrament of confirmation, soldiers of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Why soldiers? Do we have to fight? Yes, the life of the Christian is a struggle!

At baptism, your godparents said: Yes, I cleave to Jesus Christ forever. Now, now you have to repeat, Yes, I want to cleave to Jesus Christ forever. That is to say, to God; I want to obey the commandments of God, I want to obey God. That is what you must promise today.

This is the first effect of the sacrament of confirmation. And then, there is a second effect of the sacrament of confirmation, which is to make us missionaries. But missionary? I can't go to Africa; I can't go to Asia; I can't go to South America, to go and preach the Gospel.

Well, remember the example of little Thérèse. Little Thérèse of the Child Jesus did not go to Asia; she did not go to Africa; she did not go to South America. She remained in her convent; she remained in her cloister; she did not live long; she lived to the age of twenty-three. She died very young. And Pope Pius XII appointed her Patroness

of all missions.

How is this possible? A young nun of twenty-three years old who died in the Carmel of Lisieux and suddenly became patroness of all the missions.

It is because she was a great missionary. And how was she a missionary? Through prayer and sacrifice. She offered her life for the missions. She suffered a lot. She died offering her life for the missions. And we have seen that after her death, many souls were converted because she offered her life and prayed for the salvation of souls and suffered for the salvation of souls.

So, see, you too can make sacrifices and you can pray for the salvation of souls. First for your own soul and then for the salvation of all souls who are lost.

The children of Fatima said that the Blessed Virgin had shown them extraordinary things - alas - they saw hell. They were terrified. And they said, Souls descended into hell, as leaves fall to the ground.

The sacrament of confirmation gives us a special grace to try to save souls. Because when we realize that we ourselves have this great privilege of being Christians, of loving God, of serving God, we must do everything possible to ensure that others also have this privilege; that others also know God, know Our Lord and love and serve Him.
